1. FIELD INSTALLATION OF LARGER-DIAMETER ROD ON BATTERY MOUNT


As announced in Bulletin 1009 (May 9, 1963), the current production Battery Mount (Part Number ST-128) has a larger-diameter rod, 1/4-inch, attached to it by welded gussets.

To update field stocks of the Battery Mount with the 3/16-inch diameter rod, a new part has been manufactured and is now available at the Stations. As shown below, the new part consists of a 1/4-inch diameter rod welded to steel gussets.

To attach to the Battery Mount, break off the 3/16-inch diameter rod with a cold chisel. Clamp the new part on the front of the Battery Mount as shown.

Drill the required holes through the gussets and Battery Mount. We recommend riveting the part to the Battery Mount, but it may be bolted to it provided there is adequate clearance.

The new field fix bar and gussets will be available at your Stations, no charge, sometime during the week of June 10th.
