SUBJECT Westchester Starting Tip

When the Westchester has run completely out of gas, after filling the Fuel Tank, do not turn the Ignition Key fully clockwise to the starting position.

Rather, turn the Key to the first clockwise position. This engages the Fuel Pump, bringing fuel to the Carburetor. Then after about ten seconds, turn the Key to the starting position.

In other words, the only reason the Westchester would stop would be that the entire Fuel System is dry. Therefore, the Fuel System must be refilled--fuel must be pumped to the Carburetor--before the Tractor can be started.

This little gem of information can save your users lots of worry, so pass the word along.
