SUBJECT: BATTERIES

In the very near future, all batteries with the Gravelly name will have a black and white decal (see copy below) assembled to the top of the battery cover.

This decal lists the code date of the battery manufacture and the date the battery is put into service. On the decal are the 12 months of the year and four years. When you put the battery into service, remove the cut out circle for the correct month and year.

Should you have a problem on the battery and desire warranty, remove the decal and return it to Gravelly with the warranty request.

The battery cell readings are still required on the warranty request starting from the positive terminal across to the negative terminal.

WARNING DO NOT REMOVE THIS TAG

This battery contains **SULPHURIC ACID**. FLUSH IMMEDIATELY WITH LARGE AMOUNTS OF WATER in case of contact with skin, eyes or clothing. SEEK MEDICAL ATTN. **D2**
