SUBJECT: HOW TO WIRE BOLT HEADS

The sketch with this bulletin shows the proper procedure to use in wiring bolts to prevent loosening from vibration and other causes.

The principle behind such wiring is simply to wire so that the direction of force on the bolt head is always pulling to **TIGHTEN** the bolt. Careless or incorrect wiring can often increase instead of alleviate the problem.

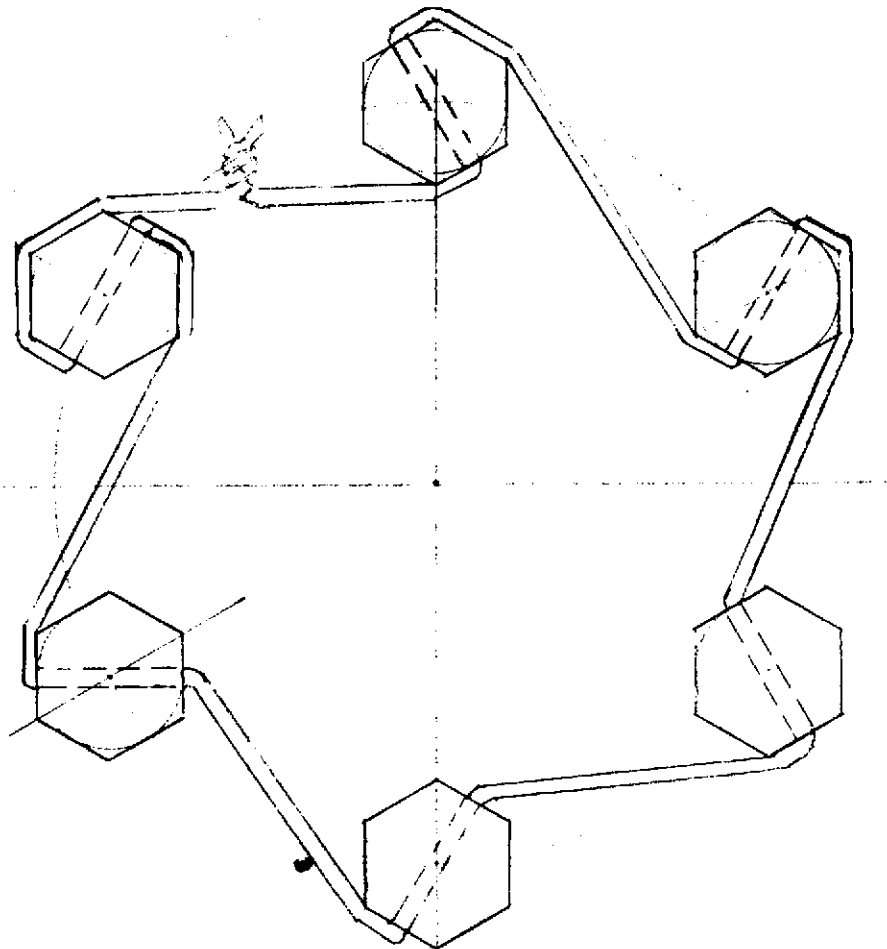
