NEW TRACTOR IMPROVEMENTS AVAILABLE DURING SEASON SERVICE

Gravelly Attachments Speed Fall Clean-Up

Fall is the time to prepare your grounds for winter's bleak months. Gravelly users find the task is made easier by taking full advantage of their powerful Tractor, by obtaining attachments that do the job faster, better, easier than hand methods and drudgery.



Clean Up Leaves Fast

Gravelly Users confirm that the Leaf Mulcher attachment for their Gravelly Rotary Mower makes short work of leaves. The danger and inconvenience of leaf raking and burning disappears.

Best Results Obtained with Lawn Sweeper-Leaf Mulcher

Even mulched leaves will damage fine lawns if left on the lawn year after year. Users suggest mulching the leaves, then sweeping the area with the Gravelly Lawn Sweeper. The lawn is left clean and attractive, protected and ready for sturdy growth in the spring.

Two sizes available: 28" width Sweeper, and a Gang Sweeper that cleans 76" at a time. Attaches to either Gravelly Sulky.



Ride While You Haul

Whether you are cleaning up trash, landscaping, moving equipment or material, hauling in firewood or cleaning up cleared land, the easy way is to ride the Gravelly Cart while the Tractor does the hauling work.

Transportation Cart hauls up to a half-ton load, dumps easily by releasing a latch.

Overhaul Best Time For Adding Improvements

Improvements in the Gravelly Tractor and its attachments have been made steadily for many years. The number of significant changes in the last year have been large. Improvements in power, and additional life

for the equipment is the result.

Season Service time is the best time to get these improvements added to your Tractor. The cost is less, since much of the work would normally be done anyway during Season Service.

Power Spreader Tested, Improved



During last winter's severe weather, the Gravelly Power Spreader was thoroughly tested. Field use reports were analyzed, and our engineering and production staff made several changes in design to meet the severest winter conditions in years.

Changes involved the spread control, an improved vibrator; and changes in the Drive. At the end of the winter season, users were reporting the equipment did a very satisfactory job in spreading salt, sand, calcium chloride with speed and efficiency.



New Power Barrow Announced

Take the muscle out of moving heavy loads with the new Power Barrow.

Now your Gravelly can haul concrete, dirt, all the small and heavy loads, with power!

The Barrow is designed to dump its load easily, and can be locked down in carrying position if desired. The Tray holds five cubic feet, hauls about 600 pounds. Wide Caster Wheel, semi-pneumatic, protects lawns, makes steering easier.

Full-Flow Oil System Adds Engine Life

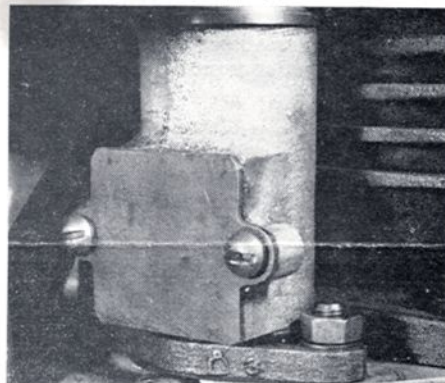
Most valuable improvement has been the addition of a full flow lubrication system. This insures that ALL oil reaching the engine has been completely filtered. The oil pump has been improved to give *twice* the volume of oil at the same pressure.

The effect is to give longer life to the Tractor, reduce the heat, and thus increase the Horsepower fractionally.

A side result has been the redesign of the Oil Strainer to give eight times the surface of the old strainer, which has proved helpful in requiring less down time for cleaning the strainer.

Valve Sticking Eliminated

A combination of Bronze Valve Guides and an electrofilming process on the Exhaust Valve has eliminated the problem of sticking valves. These items may be added to the Tractor easily during Season Service.



Valve Covers

Valve stems now are lubricated by using Valve Covers. This also helps with oil leakage around the valves, which is sometimes a problem with older Tractors.

A removable plate gives easy access to the Valve Tappets for adjustment, now simplified by a self-locking Valve Tappet.

Sediment Bowl

The Oil Filler Cap has been replaced with a high quality breather type of cap, to increase engine efficiency. The Sediment Bowl design has been changed to increase

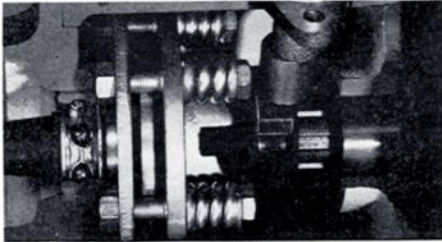

its life, using a larger bowl made of heavier, stronger glass, with sturdier fittings.

New Cast-Iron Bonded Lining Clutches

The Clutches have been changed to a very rigid and sturdy design that uses a heavy cast-iron cup, with a bonded clutch lining. This adds years to the life of the clutches, gives more positive clutching action.



Shifter Wear Block Lasts Longer

A new steel Shifter Wear Block is available. Standard on production now, it is easily added to your Gravely Tractor.

The block distributes the stress that was formerly concentrated on the tip of the Shipper Shaft. Now this stress is spread over a wide area, thus reducing the danger of breaking the tip. Wearing is at a minimum for the same reason.

Dear All Wet:

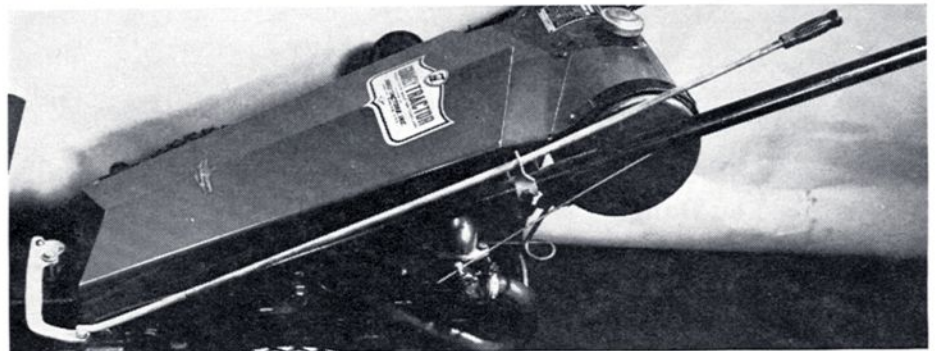
Either get your glasses changed or buy water wings for your Tractor.

Reel Mower Redesign Attachment Improvements Hailed By Users Adds Strength



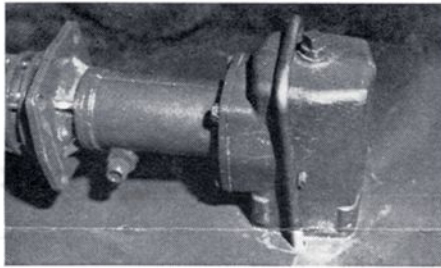
New Gravely Reel and Gang Mowers have been greatly strengthened by a series of engineering and production changes.

A heavy-duty, rigid assembly Tie-Bar and other refinements give a greater solidity to the Mower assembly, and prevents deformation of the Mower through abuse and hard service in rough terrain.

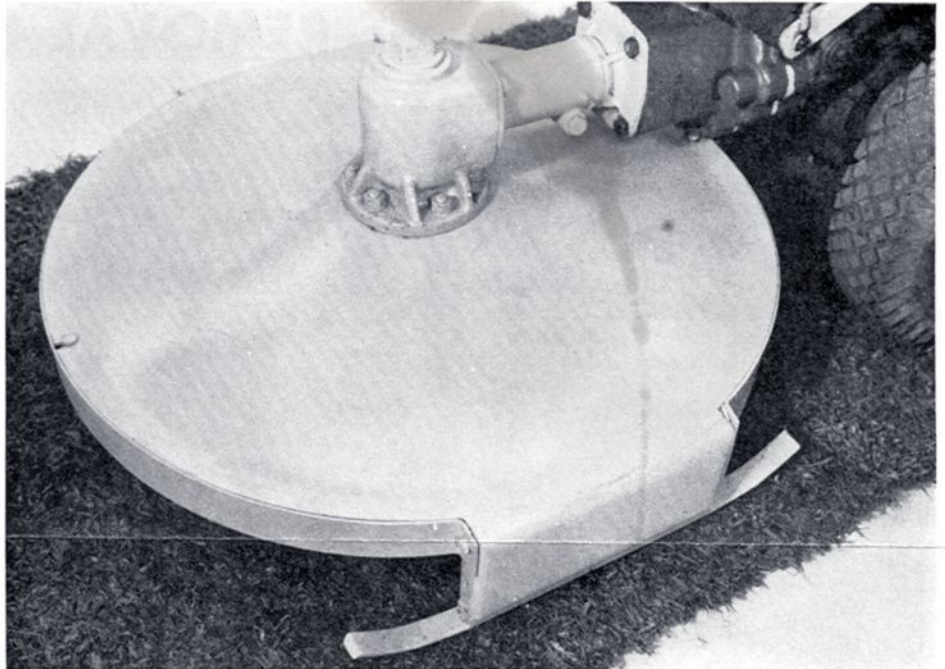
The Bed-Knife Bar assembly has been strengthened, and field reports show that the new mowers hold their cutting adjustments over a much longer period of time.

Cutting height has also been increased. Adjustments now allow cutting from 3/4 of an inch to three inches.

New Rubber Rollers and a hollow-axle which is filled with grease, giving good lubrication to the bearings in the Rollers have been added. Advantages are much longer life for the Rollers, free rolling for longer periods.

Augmented engineering staff is making rapid improvements in many attachments.

New Rotary Mower Drive

A new, one-piece Gear Housing for the Gravely Rotary Mower solves two problems... loss of oil when servicing the equipment, and longer life for the hood.

The new Housing boasts a large flange with six holes. The Hood is connected securely to the drive with six half-inch Bolts, Lockwashers and Nuts. Users of the new Drive report no difficulty with Bolts vibrating loose, or cracking at the previous bolt holes in the Hood.

Since the Housing is in one piece, Hood may be removed or replaced easier, since it is no longer necessary to use the bolts that held the former two pieces of Housing together to attach the Hood.

Repair for Older Mowers

For those Users who have experienced difficulty with older style drives, a large U-Bolt and Nuts are available which will

effectively hold the Hood securely in place.

Although this is a rare problem, certain Industrial Users and other users who do a great deal of very heavy mowing and clearing work may find the U-Bolt repair will solve their problem.

Steering Sulky Improved

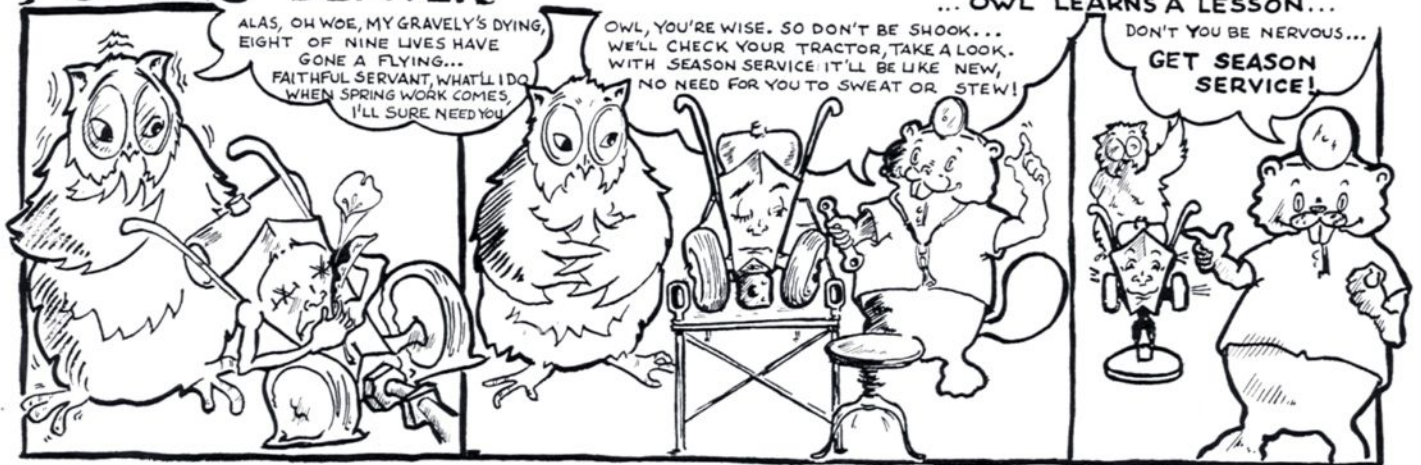
A more positive hitch to the Tractor is now a part of production Steering Sulkies, and may be applied to older Sulkies. It consists of a pair of heavy-duty "shoulder" bolts, which have the effect of giving greater stability to the Sulky. Will fit most older Sulkies, and all may be adapted to use them by drilling two 3/8" holes in the Steering Sulky Yoke.

Cable-Guide Redesigned

A Nylon Friction Bearing with cable guides molded into the Bearing abolishes the danger of corrosion or rust "freezing" the Cable Guide, allowing the cables to fray and break at this point.

Easily installed, the Bearing will add to the satisfaction of using the Steering Sulky.
